2008 Surveyors Hill Sparkling Chardonnay-Pinot Noir \$10 \$35

Hand picked Chardonnay and Pinot grapes were processed in the traditional "methode champenoise" system. The wine has a beautiful bouquet with hints of yeast, a fine and persistent bead, with rich "cremant" texture, mellow fruit flavours and a clean dry finish

White

2012 Wild Rose \$25

A fresh, vibrant and dry style wine with a savoury finish.

2014 Riesling \$35

A perfumed bouquet of citrus, musk and apple with a full and perfectly balanced palate finishing with fresh acidity

2014 Pinot Gris \$8 \$30

Subtle hints of pear and musk on the bouquet are typical of Pinot Gris and lead onto a softly textured palate with a long finish.

2015 Sauvignon Blanc \$7 \$25

A lively zesty and fruity wine with tropical fruit flavours. Especially enjoyable with Mediterranean or Asian dishes or just on its own, lightly chilled

2015 Late Harvest Quartet \$8 \$30

A combination of Riesling, Sauvignon Blanc, Chardonnay and Viognier contribute fullness of flavour and textural complexity to this slightly sweet wine with good acid balance. Paired with soft cheeses, fried fruits and sweet-savoury dishes.

Red

2011 Brio Sangiovese \$7 \$25

Intense spicy savoury bouquet leads on to a light to medium palate where again savoury spicy flavours come to the fore. A delicious wine.

2013 Shiraz (Viognier) \$10 \$35

"A medium-bodied cool climate Shiraz tropical of the Canberra District. Garnet red in colour with a lovely perfumed bouquet combining savoury and fruity elements. Soft plummy on the palate with a fine tannin finish."

2012 Cabernet Merlot \$25

The cool 2012 season delivered an intense aromatic wine with varietal red berry fruit and savoury tannins

2013 Cabernet Shiraz \$25

A classic Aussie red blend where the two varieties express ripe, bright fruit from an excellent vintage.
